Eaglehawk Announces SBX Enigma™ Entering Common Criteria Evaluation

Considered the global gold standard for evaluating information security products, the Common Criteria provides rigorous, independent, objective testing and validation of security functionality. Common Criteria certification is routinely viewed as a prerequisite for use by a multitude of government organizations worldwide.

Through international treaty, governments from 24 countries including Australia/New Zealand, Canada, France, Germany, Japan, the United Kingdom, and the United States accept Common Criteria standards and recognize evaluations and certifications from other signatories.

Eaglehawk's CEO, William Tice, stated, "SBX Enigma™ is an exceptionally unique and robust data security technology, and we believe that Common Criteria certification will provide all our public and private sector customers with the highest level of assurance regarding the data security functionality it provides."

SBX Enigma™ is a customer-hosted Web Service that provides a secure repository for any Enterprise seeking to manage access to and protect its data assets. The Common Criteria testing is being conducted by a CC accredited evaluation laboratory, Stratsec.net Pty Limited, located in Canberra, Australia, and, additionally, Eaglehawk has retained Tenix Datagate Pty Limited as technical consultant to assist during the evaluation. The Australian Defence Signals Directorate is the official CC certification authority that will be accepting the evaluation.
