Mr Rothery will speak about the *E-Security Review 2008* and *Australian Government cyber security policy*, and Mr Tice's presentation is entitled *The Security Agenda: It's Time to Share*.

About Michael Rothery

Mr Rothery heads the National Security Resilience Policy Division created in March 2009. The Division is responsible for policy, legislation, advice and programs related to developing national resilience to the full range of natural and human made hazards, including the areas of critical infrastructure protection, chemical, electronic and identity security, and protective security policy. In this position he chairs the Protective Security Policy Committee and the E-Security Policy and Coordination Committee.

Prior to this, Mr Rothery headed up the Emergency Management Policy and Liaison Branch of Emergency Management Australia, the E-Security Policy and Coordination Branch and the Critical Infrastructure Protection Branch from December 2004. Since joining the Attorney-General's Department in 1995 he has worked on counter terrorism policy and training, e-security and secure communications.

Mr Rothery first joined the Defence Science and Technology Organisation in South Australia in 1984, moving to the Defence Security Branch in 1988. A graduate of the University of Adelaide (political science) and the University of New England (public policy), he has also received training at the ADF School of Military Intelligence.

Mr Rothery is a panel member of the National Centre for Security Standards of Standards Australia, a member of the Advisory Board to the Defence and Security Applications Research Centre (UNSW at ADFA), and is chair of the Advisory Board of the Research Network for a Secure Australia.

About William Tice

Mr Tice is President and CEO of Eaglehawk Limited, a position he has held since 2001. Mr Tice has extensive executive experience in the information technology, software security, and telecommunications industries, and has frequently spoken and written on a broad range of topics involving technology change, major IT security issues facing industry and government, and enterprise-level information security strategies.

Prior to joining Eaglehawk, Mr Tice was Chief Executive Officer of Tower Distribution Technologies, Inc., a privately held infrastructure manufacturer in the US wireless industry, and was Managing Director of the IT/Telecommunications Consulting Practice for Abt Associates Inc., a \$300 million global consulting & research firm. Mr Tice began his career in the telecommunications industry with Communications Satellite Corporation, NYNEX, and Bell Atlantic.
